

**AEP Degree Track** is a two-year **A**udio **E**ngineering and **P**roduction course resulting in a Diploma. Successful completion of the AEP Diploma qualifies a student for entry on to the third year of a BA Hons in Music Production.

Entry requirements – 200 UCAS points / international equivalent. This could take the form of:

A relevant Futureworks Foundation course

At least two A2-level subjects

One A2-level subject plus one single award Advanced VCE

One double or two single award(s) Advanced VCE

Scottish Certificate of Education Higher Grade

Irish Leaving Certificate Higher Grade

International Baccalaureate

BTEC National Certificate/Diploma

Kite marked Access Course

Sufficient evidence of previous industry experience

In addition to the above, an interview presentation with the Course Leader / Head of Department.

A Full-time student on this course is expected to commit to a minimum 1,500 per year.

Average week breakdown –

6 hours lecture;

4 hours Supported Research; (extra research based project)

8 hours essential group work and supported practical;

4 hours additional group work and supported practical;

2 hours per week class / lecture consolidation;

6 hours per week preparation and reading - 3 hours essential, 2 hours recommended, 1 hour additional reading (extra research based project)

Total 30 hours per week over 50 weeks (1,500 hours) per year.

Grades are awarded Pass, Commendation, Distinction – In order to progress on to year 3 a Commendation at Diploma level is a requirement.

The qualification route is as follows;

Certificate – awarded on the successful completion of AEP year 1

Diploma – awarded on successful completion of AEP year 2

Degree, Honours – awarded on successful completion of BA Hons Music Production Year 3.

AEP student work is assessed in the form of practical submissions supported by documentary evidence and viva voce presentation.

Embedded vendor qualifications are currently assessed via online style examination.

BA Hons Music Production work is assessed in conjunction with & / by UCLAN (University of Central Lancashire)
